Donations of items, products or services for the raffles, auction or contest prizes are gratefully accepted. DEF is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. All donors will be listed in event program, any donation with the value of \$250 or more will be considered a Donation Sponsorship. Every attempt will be made to separate vendors selling similar goods or providing similar services. Please provide a SPECIFIC description of goods/services to be demonstrated and/or sold at the event (i.e. boarding, grooming, daycare, dog clothes, leashes and collars, treats, etc.) Any service to be performed on or to an animal must be approved by DEF prior to the event.

Management will try and provide vendors with the best possible location for each booth based on early reservation of space. Please state below any specific needs related to space (i.e. near a wall, a corner, need electrical hook up [\$50 fee], etc.)

#### **Vendor Booths**

A 10' x 10' space is proved with one 8' table and **two** chairs for \$175 until June 1. The booth cost will be \$200 for any registration received after May 1.

For Non-Profit Organizations, the booth cost is \$75 until May 1. The cost will be \$100 for any registration received after May 1.

An additional 5 feet of booth space is available to any vendor for the additional fee of \$75. (Extra will only be width not depth of booth)

Vendors may bring their own table and/or chairs to the event (booth fee will not be reduced). Vendors may use their own 10'x10' tent. The registration deadline is **September 1**. Vendors submitting registration after **September 1** may not be listed on the event map printed in the program.


\$200 Volunteer Shirts: Includes company logo on the back of event volunteer shirts.

#### **ADMISSION PASSES for Vendors**

Vendors that are in The Richmond Raceway Complex prior to 9:00 a.m. on the day of the event will not need admission passes.

Any additional people working at a Vendor's booth who arrive **after 9:00 a.m.** and do not present a Vendor pass **must pay for entry** to the event.

Three complimentary passes will be available to Vendors upon request (five for nonprofits).

Vendors have the option of purchasing up to 3 additional passes for \$7 each.

#### **Terms and Conditions Applies to all Vendors**

- Booths are rented on a first come, first serve basis. We reserve the right to limit the number of Direct Sales Vendors and also reserve the right to the number of vendors in a particular category.
- The DEF Dachtoberfest Management may deny any vendor application based on appropriateness of products and duplication of vendors, in such Management's sole discretion.
- Participants are responsible for the set-up and clean-up of their booths.
- Setup time will be available between 12:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Friday, October 4, 2024 and between 7:00 a.m. and 9:15 am on October 5, 2024. All vehicles MUST be out of building by 9 a.m. on event day.
- Vendors may not break down any portion of their booth <u>until at or after 4pm</u> Oct 5. Each booth must be dismantled completely no later than 6:00 p.m. day of the event.
- Vendors must keep exhibit open and staffed at all times during the event hours.
- Participants cannot impair or block other booths (e.g. sign or display blockage).
- · Vendors will not be allowed to move booth locations once a booth has been assigned, unless previously approved by DEF.
- Electrical access is an extra cost. It is priced by volts and amps. Anything over a 115 single phase 1-20 amps outlet will require a higher rental cost and advance approval from DEF.
- Vendor is responsible for all state tax on gross sales and certifies that applicable sales tax returns will be files with the appropriate states.

Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of this contract will result in the alteration or removal of the booth at the Vendor's expense. Rental fees for services and exhibit space are not refundable.

Vendors shall be bound by all pertinent laws, including building and fire code regulations, codes and regulations of municipal or other authorities, having jurisdiction over the exhibit facility or the conducting of said exhibit, including licenses and taxes, together with the rules and regulations of the owners and/or operators of the facility in which the exhibition is held.

The Richmond Raceway Complex has exclusive rights to food and beverage sales for human consumption and any such items must be ordered and purchased through them unless special arrangements have been made with Management in writing.

## **Prohibited at the Event**

- · Helium balloons (Mylar are allowed).
- The sale of puppies/dogs, kittens/cats, or any other animal.
- Onsite adoption of puppies/dogs, kittens/cats, or any other animal. (Rescues may have available animals for meet & greet purposes).
- The selling of food or beverages for human consumption (the Richmond Raceway Complex has exclusive rights to food and beverage sales unless special arrangements have been made in writing with Management).

#### **Insurance**

It is <u>strongly recommended</u> that Vendors carry general liability insurance and insurance to cover loss or damage to their exhibits or other personal property while such property is located at or is in transit to or from the exhibit site. Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation and The Richmond Raceway Complex assume no liability for any personal injury or any loss, damage or injury to any property of the Vendor or to any of its officers, agents, employees or contractors, whether attributable to accident, fire, theft or any other cause whatsoever. The Vendor expressly agrees to save and hold harmless Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation and The Richmond Raceway Complex, their board members, directors, volunteers, management, agents and employees from any and all claims, liabilities and losses for injury to persons (including death) or damage to property arising in connection with Vendor's use of the exhibit space, except such losses as may be the result of the sole negligence of Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation or The Richmond Raceway Complex.

Regardless of status of insurance, all Vendors agree to defend and to indemnify (defend any claims and pay for any damages)
Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation and The Richmond Raceway Complex against any claims made whatsoever arising out of
Vendor's participation in Dachtoberfest. The signature of Vendor's representative to this contract evidences Vendor's agreement to
indemnify the Henrico Humane Society and The Richmond Raceway Complex. This agreement to indemnify shall remain in force even
if Vendor is unable to participate in Dachtoberfest due to termination of this contract.

# **Protection of Facilities**

Nothing shall be posted on, or tacked, nailed, screwed, or otherwise attached to the columns, walls, floors, or other parts of The Richmond Raceway Complex exhibit area without permission from Management. Packing, unpacking and assembly of exhibits shall be done only in designated areas and in conformity with directions of Management.

Any damage to The Richmond Raceway Complex property will be repaired at Vendor's expense. Any cleaning expenses incurred due to the Vendor shall be reimbursed by Vendor.

#### **Refund Policy**

If, after executing this contract, the Vendor is unable to occupy the exhibit space for any reason other than fault of Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation, written notification of termination must be sent to Management. **The registration payment is not refundable.** Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation reserves the right to resell the exhibit space immediately.

If a Vendor fails to comply in any material respect with the terms of this agreement, then Management shall have the right to terminate this agreement and resell the Vendor's space. Upon termination of the agreement, there shall be no refund due to a Vendor.

Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation will not be liable for the fulfillment of this contract as to the delivery of exhibit space if non-delivery is due to reasons not within the control of the Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation. These include, but are not limited, to the following: problems with the facility such as loss of electricity, flooding, fire, or damage to The Richmond Raceway Complex; postponement/cancellation by The Richmond Raceway Complex; inclement weather; strikes; war; act of God or other cause beyond the control of Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation; government-mandated capacity or other restrictions related to COVID-19.

In the event of the cancellation of Dachtoberfest for any of the above-named reasons, Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation will reimburse Vendor minus a 20% cancellation fee on the amount paid. This is to cover all legitimate expenses incurred by Dachshund Enlightenment Foundation, such as but not limited to: rent, advertising, promotion fees, or other operation costs, etc.
